
Regulation # 10- Leelanau County

WC – 10 – 94 – 001 Glen Lake and Little Glen Lake: Slow-no wake speed

On the waters of Glen Lake and Little Glen Lake, all within sections 32 and 33, T29N, R14W, Glen Arbor Township, Leelanau County, in the channel connecting Glen Lake and Little Glen Lake, for a distance of 200 feet easterly and westerly of the M-22 bridge, it is unlawful for the operator of a vessel to exceed a slow-no wake speed.

The boundaries of the area described immediately above shall be marked with signs and with buoys. All buoys must be placed as provided in a permit issued by the Department of Natural Resources and be in conformance with the State Uniform Waterway Marking System.
