

Supplement To: "Public Safety and Fire Emergency Response Cost Recovery"
November 15, 2005

This list of approximate costs may be used to assist the Township Board in determining the amount of assessable costs. It should be used in conjunction with Section 5 of the Ordinance. This list should be updated yearly or, as mentioned in Section 5, before assessment of costs for a particular Public Safety or Fire Emergency Response.

Motor Vehicle Accidents: (With no hazardous material released)

(For owners of vehicles who own property within Glen Arbor Township)

When extrication tools are used: **\$0.00**

(For owners of vehicles who do not own property within Glen Arbor)

When extrication tools are used: (Per vehicle) **\$250.00**

Utility Line Failure:

(When response by the utility company is made within an hour :) **\$0.00**

(For response of over an hour :) **\$35.81**
(Per hr. per person)

Cost after first hour based on units required to stand by at scene, based on the need as seen by the chief or the Incident Commander:

Pumper: 311	\$126.00 per hour after the first hour.
Pumper: 312	\$217.00 per hour after the first hour
Pumper/Tanker: 321	\$164.00 per hour after the first hour
Mini-Pumper: 341	\$76.00 per hour after the first hour
Light Rescue: 351	\$74.00 per hour after the first hour
Rehab Bus: 381	\$76.00 per hour after the first hour
Port. Hydrant: 382	\$67.00 per hour after the first hour
ALS Ambulance: 391	\$37.00 per hour after the first hour
BLS Ambulance: 392	\$37.00 per hour after the first hour
ALS Echo: 393	\$27.00 per hour after the first hour
Command Car: 301	\$27.00 per hour after the first hour

For times over one hour, billing will be broken down into half hour increments, at the cost of one-half the per hour charge. Times will be taken from the Leelanau County dispatch log, and will start at the time of dispatch and end when unit returns to station.
